## Sticky Toffee Pudding

### PUDDINGS

2oz / 55g	BUTTER	1 teaspoon BAKING POWDER
6oz / 170g	CASTER SUGAR	1teaspoon BICARBONATE OF SODA
1 LARGE EGG		6oz / 170g chopped dates
Half pint BOILING WATER		1 teaspoon vanilla essence
8oz / 225g	PLAIN FLOUR	

### TOPPING

2oz / 55g	BUTTER	2 tablespoons DOUBLE CREAM
	3oz / 80g	SOFT BROWN SUGAR
	1 tablespoon	TREACLE

Makes 6-8 individual puddings.

Grease the puddings moulds and pre-heat the oven to 190 C / 375 F.

Cream together the butter and sugar then add the egg and beat well.

Sift the flour and baking powder together and fold into the creamed mixture. Pour boiling water over the dates then add the bicarbonate of soda and vanilla essence. Add to the creamed mixture and mix well.

Put into pudding moulds and bake for 20-25 minutes.

To make the topping place the butter, sugar, cream and treacle in a pan and heat. Stir until mixed and the sugar has dissolved.

Turn out the puddings and pour over the sauce then serve.
