# **CLYDESDALE HORSES**

- ◆ Every exhibit must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of the entry and continue to be so up to and including the day of the show.
- ◆ The Veterinary Surgeons shall be empowered to expel from the Showground any equine, which in their opinion, is suffering from or affected by any contagious or infectious disease likely to prove harmful to other equines, or any equine which in their opinion is unfit for exhibition. The Veterinary Surgeons shall issue a certificate recording their findings.
- ◆ In accordance with the Health and Safety Legislation's all equestrian exhibitors/competitors/grooms must now comply with the above. Total separation between equines and the general public may in certain instances be impossible and it is suggested that if any exhibitor has a nervous/highly strung equine he/she should consider whether it is prudent for him/her to risk bringing this animal to the showground. Children should not be allowed to handle any large or fractious animal. An adult should always be in attendance to take over if a child is having difficulty maintaining control of any animal.
